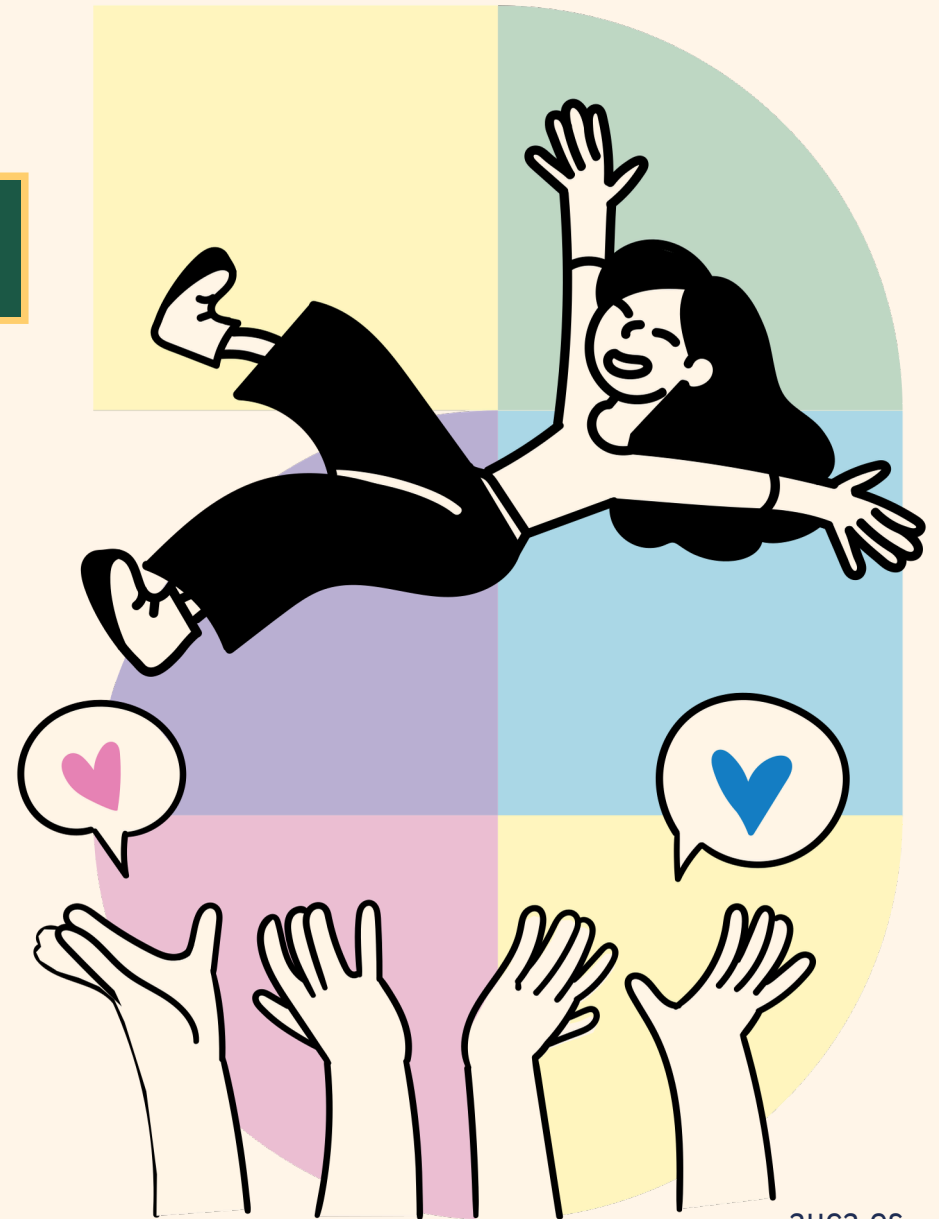

Dear families,

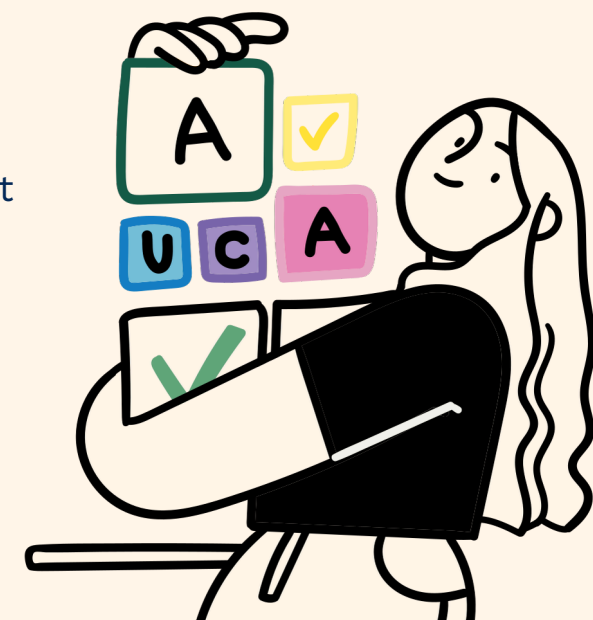

Rules for After-School Workshops 2026-27

GENERAL

1. After-school activities will take place on Wednesdays and Fridays in two time slots: from 13:45 to 15:00 and from 15:00 to 16:15. Nursery collection will take place at 16:00.
2. If a pupil is registered for two days a week, they must attend the same workshop on both Wednesday and Friday
3. During these hours, no pupil may remain on the school premises unless they are taking part in one of the after-school activities in the first or second time slot, or are using the El Faro childcare service
4. To guarantee the quality of each workshop, once the maximum number of registrations has been reached, no further pupils will be accepted and a waiting list will be opened. A new group will be opened when the minimum number of participants is reached, provided that suitable spaces are available at the school.
5. For the robotics workshops (NANOBOTS, BYTEBOTS and MEGABOTS), registrations will only be accepted for two days a week, not for just one day a week, due to the methodology of the workshop.
6. The minimum number required to open a workshop is 9 participants.
7. The running of after-school activities is subject to the availability of suitable spaces at the school.
8. Cancellations or changes to workshops must be notified before the 25th of the month. No changes will be allowed once the month has begun.
9. Pupils with Special Educational Needs will be assessed on an individual basis, especially those who have a personal assistant during the school day. Under no circumstances can a personal assistant service be provided during after-school activities.
10. Auca Projectes Educatius is not responsible for the loss, damage or inappropriate use of pupils' personal belongings, such as musical instruments, clothing, rackets, etc



Rules for After-School Workshops 2026-27

PRE-ENROLMENT

1. Pre-enrolment period: from 1 to 14 June 2026.
2. **Pre-enrolment does not guarantee that the requested place will be obtained.**
3. Places will be allocated according to the following criteria:
 - a. Strict order of receipt of the pre-enrolment submitted through our Aucademy platform. Please select all the options offered, 3 per activity block.
 - b. Participants already enrolled in the 2025–2026 school year, with regard to continuity in the requested activity.
4. A total of 20% of the places available for each activity will be reserved for new pupils of the European School until 15 days after the start of the activities, provided that these places have not been filled during the first application period.
5. Once registration for new pupils of the European School has finished, pupils on the WAITING LIST will be contacted for the allocation of available places.
6. At the end of the place allocation process, you will receive confirmation of the final enrolment by email, using the email address provided during pre-enrolment.

2. Collections outside normal hours must be notified in advance by email before 12:00 noon or by calling the coordinator on 607 921 801. Children must be collected from the Primary entrance.

RESPECT AND RESPONSIBILITY

1. Pupils must comply with the EEA Internal Regulations, as well as Auca's Regulations for After-School Activities.

2. Any damage intentionally caused by pupils to the facilities or to third parties must be paid for by their parents or legal guardians. Pupils may also be excluded from the activities in which they participate.

3. Auca may refuse a pupil's participation in any activity when there are justified circumstances for doing so.



Rules for After-School Workshops 2026-27

FEES AND PAYMENTS

1. The company will charge the activity fees by direct debit between the 1st and 5th of each month.
2. Returned direct debits will incur a surcharge of €2.50 as a bank charge.
3. Once the month has begun, no refunds of any kind will be issued.
4. Activity fees are monthly and are calculated on a pro-rata basis according to the duration of the service, regardless of the number of activity days or the pupil's absences.
5. Non-attendance does not imply cancellation of the activity. Therefore, the corresponding fees must be paid until cancellation has been effectively confirmed.
6. Cancellation of activities must be requested by email before the 25th of the month prior to cancellation at the following address: coordinadora-eu@auca.es. Auca will confirm receipt of the cancellation request

PRICES

Two-day workshops will cost €30 per month, except for:

1. Robotics (Nanobots, Bytebots and Megabots) €43 per month.
2. Minichef and Superchef €39 per month.
3. Funny Art and Creative Constructions €39 per month.
4. Competitive Sports, School League €39 per month, from November to May.
